

This trip is designed for active people who enjoy the outdoors. On our 7-night Dalmatian cruise you have the option of cycling or just cruising & exploring towns on foot.

DAY 1 - 07 SEP DUBROVNIK

On arrival in the "Pearl of the Adriatic" you will be transferred to our hotel. Rest of day free. Accommodation: Dubrovnik 4* Hotel - 2 nights

DAY 2 - 08 SEP DUBROVNIK SIGHTSEEING

We'll begin our day with a scenic drive to the top of **Mt. Srd**, where you'll enjoy unique views of the Old Town and the beautiful Elafiti Islands. Afterward, we'll be dropped off just outside the **Old Town** for a walking tour of this UNESCO World Heritage Site, featuring charming squares and centuries-old red-roofed buildings. The tour will wrap up around 1pm, giving us time to find a place for lunch. Then, we'll walk the ancient **Dubrovnik Walls**, which offer a completely different perspective of this stunning city. The walk covers approximately 2 km.

DAY 3 - 09 SEP DUBROVNIK - SPLIT

This morning we will transfer by road to Split. On arrival, check in to our hotel located right in the **Old Town** – a hodgepodge of every possible historic and architectural style with different cultural influences. It is packed with Gothic and Renaissance mansions, small boutiques, coffee shops, bars and restaurant and is home to around 2000 local residents. This afternoon we're on a walking tour of the **Diocletian's Palace**, former retirement home of the roman emperor Diocletian. We will also visit the Substructure of the Palace (aka the Basement Halls) – one of the



best preserved and most impressive Roman monuments in the world. The tour then continues into the **Peristyle** where we visit the Cathedral and the Temple of Jupiter.

DAY 4 - 10 SEP DALMATIAN ISLAND CYCLE CRUISE

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast, before checking out and walking to the ship. We depart from Split harbour at 1pm with lunch served onboard, as we get to know our fellow shipmates. Once we arrive, you will be fitted for your Ebike. Our first ride begins as we cycle to **Bobovišça**, a small hamlet set on the western side of Brac just under the mountain top, overlooking the sea. Option to take a swim in the warm turquoise water, have a drink, or perhaps continue riding along the stunning coastline. We spend the night in the harbour of **Milna**, whose picturesque natural stone houses border the deep bay.

DAY 5 – 11 SEP DALMATIAN ISLAND CYCLE CRUISE

Today, we'll embark on an exciting and fulfilling cycling adventure around **Brac** Island. Our journey kicks off with a climb to the hilltop, where you'll be surrounded by breathtaking local flora & views. Interestingly, the white stone found here was used to build the White House in Washington and the Reichstag in Berlin. At the 35km mark, you'll have the option to enjoy a traditional lunch of peka and local wine (own expense). The panoramic views of the neighboring island of Hvar make the climb truly rewarding. Afterward, we'll coast down to **Bol**, where you can explore the famous **Golden Horn beach**, take a refreshing swim, or wander through the charming streets. We'll spend the night anchored in Bol, with dinner served onboard.

DAY 6 – 12 SEP DALMATIAN ISLAND CYCLE CRUISE

This morning, we'll set sail for **Hvar** Island, renowned for its vibrant fields of rosemary and lavender. Our first cycling stage will take us through charming villages along both paved and



gravel roads. We'll start in **Jelsa**, then cycle towards **Vrboska** before heading down to **Stari Grad**, one of Croatia's oldest towns, dating back to 385 BC, where we'll take a refreshing break.

From there, we'll continue towards Hvar Town, passing through **Grablje**, famous for its wine and olive oil. We'll wrap up the day in the historic town of **Hvar**, where we'll spend the night. This beautiful old town offers a variety of waterfront restaurants to enjoy.

DAY 7 – 13 SEP DALMATIAN ISLAND CYCLE CRUISE

This morning, we'll set off for the stunning island of **Korčula**, famously believed to be the birthplace of Marco Polo. After lunch, we'll begin our ride from **Račišće to Lumbarda**, known for its excellent wine production. The tranquil gardens of cypress trees lining the route make cycling on Korčula truly unforgettable. Our journey will lead us to the medieval town of Korčula, renowned for its charming narrow streets. There's plenty of dining options in this cool town, and if you have the energy the nightlife is also excellent.

DAY 8 – 14 SEP DALMATIAN ISLAND CYCLE CRUISE

While breakfast is served onboard, we'll sail to the stunning island of **Mljet**, often referred to as Honey Island. This beautiful destination features two picturesque lakes: the Great Lake and the Small Lake. In the 12th century, Benedictines established a monastery in a secluded area, surrounded by lush pine and oak forests. Today, this region is a national park and a highlight of any Dalmatian tour. You'll have the opportunity to cycle around the park's saltwater lake, which even has another island within it. After lunch, feel free to explore more of the island by bike, or enjoy a swim or kayak in the Small Lake. We'll spend the night in the port of **Pomena**.

DAY 9 – 15 SEP DALMATIAN ISLAND CYCLE CRUISE – MAKARSKA

This morning, we cruise to the **Pelješac Peninsula**, where we'll begin our ride from either **Kučište or Viganj**, cycling through this renowned wine-growing region towards **Orebic**. There is a challenging climb, but the breathtaking views make it so worthwhile! We'll reconvene with the boat in **Lovište**, where a delicious lunch will be served onboard. Relax on the sun deck with a cool beverage as we cruise on to the charming town of **Makarska**, nestled at the base of the impressive Biokovo mountain range.

DAY 10 - 16 SEP DALMATIAN ISLAND CYCLE CRUISE

After breakfast onboard, we'll embark on our final bike ride to **Radmanove Mlinice**, where the "Winnetou" movies were filmed, following the scenic valley of the **Cetina River** beneath the mountains. In **Omis**, you'll have the chance to visit the Mirabella Fortress, which provides stunning views of the Adriatic. Enjoy lunch onboard as we sail back to **Split**, reflecting on our incredible journey. A night out in Split's vibrant old town is an option, or you might prefer to relax onboard.

DAY 11 - 17 SEP SIBENIK - VISOVAC - PLITVICE

After breakfast, we'll bid farewell to our shipmates and meet our local driver/guide. Our journey takes us up the coast to the beautiful town of **šibenik** for a guided walk through the historic old town. After lunch at a special local restaurant, we'll drive to **Visovac** and take a small boat to this tiny island home to a Franciscan monastery that houses a valuable collection of manuscripts and rare books. Afterward, we'll continue driving north to **Plitvice**, where we'll overnight just outside the National Park.

DAY 12 - 18 SEP PLITVICE LAKES - ZAGREB

Up early to beat the crowds and enter the **National Park**. Plitvice's exceptional beauty makes it one of Croatia's main attractions. The Park consists of 300 km² of forest and its 16 picturesque cascading lakes make up just 1% of the park. We'll spend a few hours roaming along the park trails and admiring the views. Later today, arrive in the capital **Zagreb** and have a short orientation walking tour of the city centre. Celebrate our last night together, with a farewell dinner & drinks.
